Two BAA classes, *Advanced Portrait Painting*, and *Hand Building with Clay* are full, and we are starting a waiting list for the next session of these classes.



Figure and Gesture Drawing/Doll Making with instructor Pepper Hume meets on three Monday evenings from 6-8pm. After the initial 4 weeks of drawing students may continue with Pepper and transition into Doll Making.

Doll Making Class will make a Christmas Angel doll over four weeks. Class is open to adults and high school students and cost is \$30 for Drawing Class or \$10 a session, and Doll Making is \$40 or \$10 per class and \$10 materials fee.

Before potters had the wheel, they were creating beautiful pots and clay forms using clay, their hands and fingers, and basic hand tools. The class will have a fall theme, using great foliage to imprint and add foliage shape. Pottery will be functional and food safe, ideal for fall entertaining or for holiday gifts.
